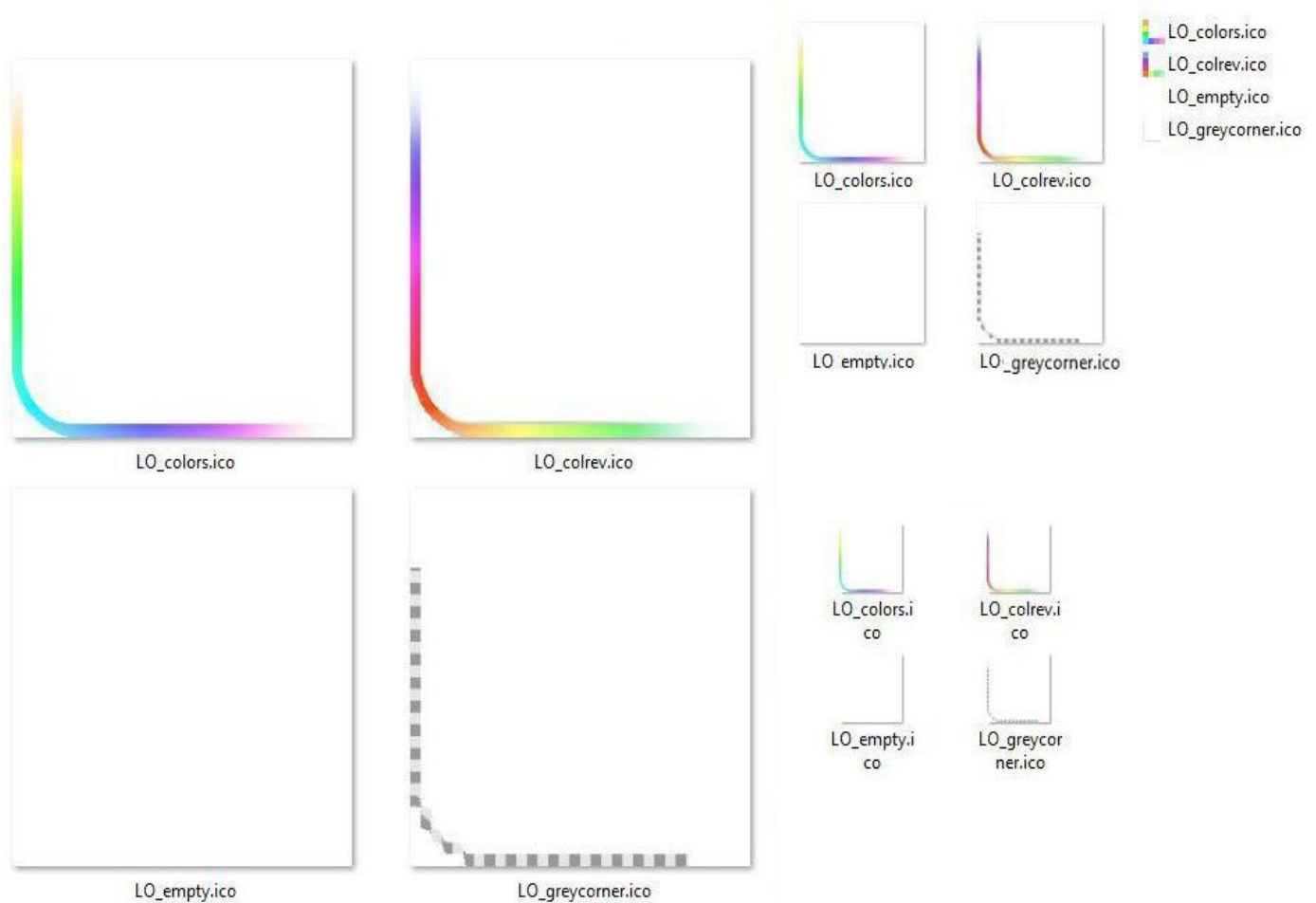


Installing Your Custom Link-Overlay-Icon on Windows

This Folder contains four different Link-Overlay-Icons



It also contains an icon called `LinkOverlay.ico` which is identical to `LO_colors.ico`

If this Folder is `C:\OverlayIcon` and you want `LO_colors` as Overlay-Icon, just double-click `LinkOverlayIcon.reg`, confirm, that you want to merge it with the registry and restart your computer.

If you want to use another icon, just delete `LinkOverlay.ico`, put the icon you want in this Folder and rename it to `LinkOverlay.ico`

As the registry looks for `C:\OverlayIcon\LinkOverlay.ico` you can exchange this icon at any time, and it will be your overlay icon, after the next restart.

You'll always have to restart your computer to make a changes effective!

If you want another path or filename, edit `LinkOverlayIcon.reg` with any text-editor and adjust path and filename. Be aware of the the double-backslashes in this file (as the whole path stands in doublequotes, dolequotes and backslashes are escaped with a backslash, resulting in `\` and `\\`)

It should look something like this:

Windows Registry Editor Version 5.00

```
[HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE\SOFTWARE\Microsoft\Windows\CurrentVersion\Explorer\Shell Icons]
"29"="\\C:\\Icons Folder\\System Icos\\MyCoolLink.ico\\"
```

Save the file, double-click it, confirm merging and restart your computer.

Of course, the icon has to have the correct name and must be stored in the correct folder
